

Rendezvous/YDF show minutes  
April 8, 2009

Meeting was called to order at 8:03 p.m. The secretary's report was given by Laurel Hanlon, at the march clinic two youth attended and the rest of the people who attended were non-RMPHA members and the clinic was said to be a lot of fun. The treasurer's report was given by Bailey Johnston our current balance is \$ 6,404.53. At the clinic the money was split three ways, amateur, general, and RMjPHC and \$265 went to each. A motion was presented by Katie and seconded by Amy to pass the treasurer's report, the motion passed.

In old business: there are year-end requirement changes. People can now pay for their hours; every \$50 dollars donated is equivalent to 30 min towards your hours. You have to turn in a donation sheet with the appropriate information to get credit for it. If you go on the RMPHA website, under the youth section, you can see your hours, donations, and meetings attended; also remember that youth must work their own hours except walk-trotters who can have their parents work up to two hours for them.

Our year fundraising goals are the stall decorating contest which was done at the Rendezvous/YDF show. Awards were given out, IOU coupons can be put in bins if you couldn't pay right away and you wanted it to be put on your bill instead and pay for it at the end of the show. Bins will be set up right outside the show office. The voting will end on Saturday with two awards given: most creative stall and most votes. The balloon raffle is scheduled to happen on Saturday, and possibly have separate categories (\$5, \$10, \$25, and \$50 balloons, depending on the items donated).

At the Colorado Gold show, there will be an art contest. The artwork has to be related to the paint horse; the artwork will auctioned off in a silent auction. Two categories will be awarded prizes, 1<sup>st</sup> – 3<sup>rd</sup> in the judged portion & 1<sup>st</sup> – 3<sup>rd</sup> in the highest selling art-work in the silent auction. 1st place will get 2 credit hours, 2<sup>nd</sup> place will get 1 credit hour, and 3<sup>rd</sup> place will get a ½ credit hour going towards the year-end requirements. The motion was presented by Amy and seconded by Bailey to award credit hours to the winners, motion passed. Another motion was presented by Amy and seconded by Breanna to have two sections of winners, one for the judged event and one for the highest selling winner, motion passed. Discussion about which divisions the art could be categorized into were: photography, drawing, and 3D, but may be adjusted after all artwork has been submitted.

For the Fall Flannel show there was discussion about tack cleaning, a bake sale, and a cake raffle for fundraising opportunities.

In new business: the next meeting is May 2<sup>nd</sup> at Castle Rock at the Village Inn. The Youth meeting will begin at 10, and the General meeting will begin at 12/noon.

The team tournament was discussed, and who's going. It will be a combined RMjPHC/HPJPHC team – those that expressed interest at the meeting were Breanna, Katie, and Amy. If you are interested in participating, please let Lindsey Berbee or Heather Sarno know as soon as possible.

Zone 3 is paying for one person to go to the convention from each of the Zone clubs. RMjPHC decided to allow anonymous votes to determine who the recipient of the paid tuition would be. Please submit your vote/nomination to Lindsey no later than May 1<sup>st</sup>.

The summer sizzler will be held at the Douglas County Fairgrounds, with the Open classes held on Friday and the Youth/Amateur classes held on Saturday & Sunday. Any upcoming shows will be a good place to get your hours in, if you would like to help please contact Sue Willard to sign up.

Reminders- If you would like to be recognized and your points count for Rookie of the Year, be sure to submit your signed declaration to Lindsey. Your points will begin accumulating as soon as the declaration has been received.

Motion to adjourn the meeting was made by Beth and seconded by Breanna. Motion passed, meeting adjourned.
